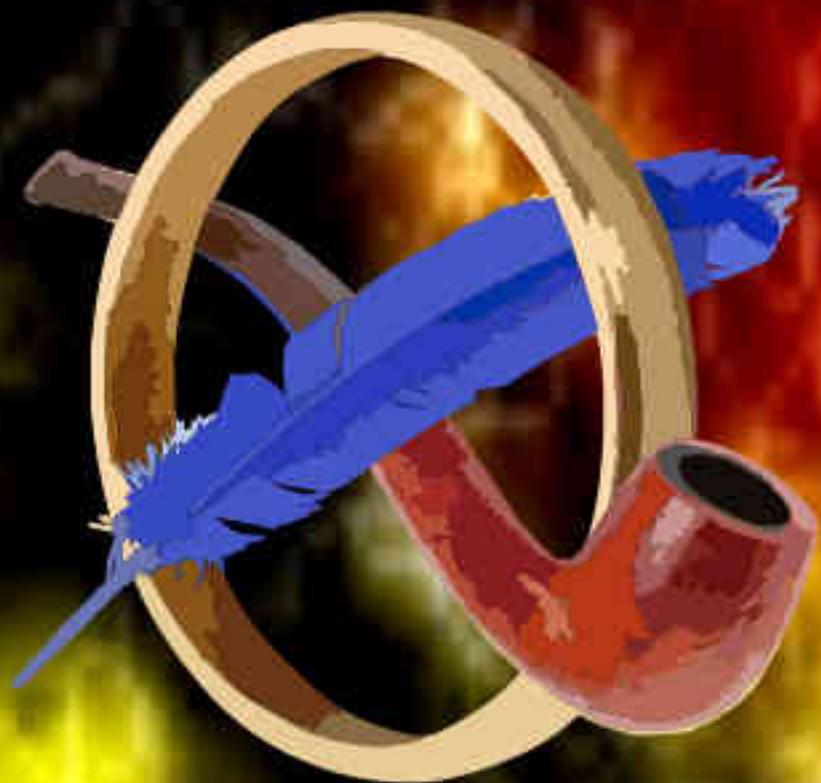

CAAM 2009 – DISCOVER THE DARK SIDE!

The [Hungarian Tolkien Society](#) proudly announces its Creative Autumnal Art Meeting, the "CAAM", to be held on the 22nd – 25th October, 2009. It is taking place at [Zebegény](#), a charming little town of the Danube's Bend, one of the most favoured, picturesque places of Hungary.

The CAAM is about creativity, skills and fun, organized around and based on Tolkien's heritage, therefore it is usually framed by a Tolkien-inspired event, location or situation. This year the theme is about a camp in Mordor, with different species of Sauron's creatures, and their captives. All the species and the captives work together in their chosen field of art, and co-operate with other groups, to create performances or installations for the last night's gala and the exhibition.

Our brand new "tradition" from last year is that we invite our friends from foreign countries, who share our love and devotion to Tolkien's lore, to come and join this meeting, share skills and games with us, and enjoy the creativity, friendly talks and whatever may come with all these. Since Hungarian language is pretty difficult to learn and speak, we provide English-speaking translators. Some of our members will speak German or French, too. We will break the language barriers, or at least, jump over them!

The CAAM starts on Thursday, 22nd October 2009, because the 23rd of October is a bank holiday in Hungary. We understand, that it is difficult to get here on workdays, either because of school or work, but we are ready to welcome you on both on the 22nd or the 23rd. The days will be packed with different activities, such as workshops, sports, talks, games to play, and nice hikes in the Börzsöny Mountain's uninhabited forests. Everybody will find hers/his cup of tea!

For the last day, Sunday, we are planning only a short "official" programme, so later we'll invite our foreign friends to visit Visegrad, a historical site near Zebegény, on the other bank of the Danube.

The price of the event for 3 nights costs HUF 6000. For our foreign visitors we will provide a reduced price (HUF 5100) if you come at least four of you. (Unfortunately, we cannot accept foreign currency, not even euros, sorry!) This includes a place to stay (have fun, chat, etc.) for 3 nights, and breakfast for 3 mornings. The price also includes the costs of the workshops and of the organization process. It does not include lunch and dinner, but if you arrive in time on 22nd evening, you may enjoy fine and traditional Hungarian dishes, prepared on open fire, right from the kettle. That is something special you may not want to miss!

Accommodation fits into the event's theme: the program is organized in the town's school, where the classrooms will provide a place for sleep, therefore a sleeping bag or other suitable accessory is necessary. If you preferred more comfort and privacy, you may ask for a pension room, as there are plenty of them in town, but remember to keep in mind that the event falls on one of our national holidays, so you should apply as soon as possible to have a vacant room. Pension rooms are not covered by the prices, and ought to be paid separately. If you apply in time and ask for a pension room, we will do our best to book one for you!
